## I. Day 1 – 14<sup>th</sup> February :

1) **Field work:** Planting 6000 mangrove baby trees & organizing WTA with local people in TPI Mangunharjo (07 :00- 15 :00)

### 2) **Feedback about filed work: (19:00- 19:30)**

- Dore: More information about the techniques, more organisations (group divided into smaller groups). Evaluation with the number of trees grown from the seeds planted.
- Phuong: Provide more introduction and guidelines
- Phuc: Interactions with volunteers but some volunteers did not know how to plant mangroves so should have more instructions in next time.
- Kai: some exchanges between the volunteers from different workcamps and groups, more organic material
- Fung: more introductions among the participants, more mangrove trees to be planted
- Phuong: more group spirit despite lack of time
- Hang: more knowledge about the WTA, common actions from the organisation team.
- Oshin: more time to interact.
- Kai: good idea of Valentine's gifts exchanges

##### **4.3 VPV:**

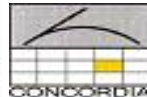
- Planting trees in a national park (weekend workcamps) but no Tanzaku papers
